



REGATHERING PLAN

We look forward to regathering together with our children and teaching them about Jesus! Please read the following plans and procedures to help keep your children and our volunteers safe.

○ **Check In**

- We will check-in in the BACK (North) entrance lobby, please park in the back of the church.

○ **Drop Off**

- Upon entering each child will need to use hand sanitizer.
- Safety is our top concern. To limit exposure of others to our children, we ask parents to not enter the classroom. If there are extenuating circumstances, please ask one of the volunteer workers.

○ **During Class**

- All surfaces and toys will be disinfected prior to the service.
- Snack will be prepackaged.
- It is not mandatory for children to wear masks. However, with parent instruction, the child can wear a mask during the entire class time. Please let the front volunteer know about your request.

Pick Up

- You will need to show your pickup tag. The volunteer will initial your child out.

○ **Health Check**

- Children that exhibit any of these symptoms are asked to not attend until they have been symptom free for 48 hours, including, but not limited to: runny nose, cough, red eyes, skin rash, diarrhea and lethargy.
- Each family and volunteer must answer “No” to the following questions:
 - *Have you or your child experienced any fever or flu-like symptoms in the past week?*
 - *Have you or your child been exposed to someone who you know or believe has the Coronavirus in the past 14 days?*

○ **Enhanced Cleaning Procedures**

- Staff and volunteers will need to sanitize their hands upon entering and exiting the rooms and throughout the service.
- All surfaces and toys will be disinfected prior to each service time and throughout the service.
- Snack will be prepackaged and served on disposable napkins and cups.
- All door handles will be disinfected prior to the service.

○ **Family Responsibility**

- We ask that all families exercise personal responsibility in efforts to keep all kids and families healthy and safe. In addition to the other policies and procedures outlined here, and in addition to our general policies, we ask families to observe and respect the following expectations:
 - Please do not bring children who have experienced any cold or flu-like symptoms within the past week (with or without fever).
 - Notify us if/when any member of their immediate family has been diagnosed or directly exposed to someone diagnosed with COVID-19, or if/when any child begins experiencing cold or flu-like symptoms.
