



What to expect on Sundays

We look forward to welcoming our children and teaching them about Jesus! Please read the following plans and procedures to help keep your children and our volunteers safe.

- **Check In**
 - All children birth-4th grade are checked in the Back North Lobby. Most convenient parking is located in the north/northeast lots.
 - Each child will receive two name tags, one for their shirt and one for the classroom teacher. They will also receive a receipt sticker that is **REQUIRED** for pick-up.
- **Drop Off**
 - Each child's name tag has their assigned classroom number printed. Children are expected to be dropped off to their assigned classroom. All classrooms are numbered above their door.
 - Upon entering each child will need to use hand sanitizer.
 - Safety is our top concern. We ask parents to not enter the classroom. If there are extenuating circumstances, please ask one of the volunteer workers for assistance.
- **What to expect during Class time?**
 - Children will experience connection with other students, worship, live teaching and/or video message, small group discussion, crafts, activities and games. Each week your child will learn a "Big Idea" and be challenged to learn the monthly memory verse.
 - All surfaces and toys will be disinfected prior to the service.
 - Snack will be prepackaged.
- **Pick Up**
 - You will need to show your pickup receipt sticker and initial your child out.
 - In the event of a receipt sticker being lost, ID will be required to pick up your child.
- **Family Responsibility / Keeping our Church Healthy**
 - Children that exhibit any of these symptoms are asked to not attend until they have been symptom free for 48 hours, including, but not limited to: fever, runny nose, cough, red eyes, skin rash, diarrhea and lethargy.
 - Each family and volunteer must answer "No" to the following questions:
 - *Have you or your child experienced any fever or flu-like symptoms in the past week?*
 - *Have you or your child been exposed to someone who you know or believe has the Coronavirus in the past 10 days?*
 - We ask that all families exercise personal responsibility in efforts to keep all kids and families healthy and safe. In addition to the other policies and procedures outlined here, and in addition to our general policies, we ask families to observe and respect the following expectations:
